Crisp, full-bodied, rich, fine mousse, toasty finish, citrus flavor, ultra fine bubbles, 24-month triage

Gruet, Blanc de Noir, Albuquerque, New Mexico, NV 10 40

Rich, toasty characteristics, balanced, aged 2 years, berry aroma, creamy texture, flavor of raspberry

Nino Franco, Rustico Prosecco, Veneto, Italy, NV 14 56

Flavors of fresh fruits, notes of bread dough and citrus, persistent effervescence, medium body, dry

ROSE

Pares Balta, Rose Cabernet-Merlot Blend, Barcelona, Spain, 2007 7 32

Aromas of raspberry and cherry with a taste that is light and fresh, light sweetness from the residual sugar

Bodegas Muga, Tempranillo Rose, Rioja, Spain, 2008 8 32

Aromatic nose of red currant and wild strawberries; dry, concentrated berry with flavors of orange zest and ginger

Domaine du Tariquet, Rose, Southwest France, 2008 10 40

Subtle yet intense aroma of spice, wild raspberry, and flowers, while the mouth is fresh, fruit driven, with a slight spiciness

WHITE

Evolution, Blend, Willamette Valley, Oregon, NV 12 48

A blend of nine varietals, which create a smooth and layered flavor

Dr. Loosen, Riesling, Mosel, Germany, 2008 8 32

Mineral-inflected varietal that is fruity, crisp, and refreshing

Botani Moscatel Seco, Muscat, Malaga, Spain, 2008 12 48

Fragrant nose of spring flowers, honey, melon, and tropical fruits; dry, crisp, and well balanced with citrus notes

J. Vineyards, Pinot Gris, Russian River Valley, California, 2007 11 44

Aromas of honeysuckle, orange blossom, and star jasmine with flavors of white peach, Asian pear, and cinnamon

Castello Di Gabbiano, Pinot Grigio, Tre Venezie, Italy, 2007 8 32

Floral notes with pear and honeydew and citrus flavors with green apple, orange, and lemon, light body

Matua, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2008 8 32

A vibrant and aromatic Sauvignon Blanc displaying lifted gooseberry and pear characters
